Heart screenings are recommended for men and women ages 40-70 with one or more of the following risk factors: diabetes, history of smoking, high BP, high cholesterol and/or family history of heart disease.

Healthy Heart CT Scans are also available during the above dates and offered on an ongoing basis at Advocate Sherman Hospital and our Outpatient Center locations. This 15-minute test detects calcium deposits in the heart, an early sign of heart disease. The cost is \$85.
